President's Comments:

Sorry that we missed the Spring Show and September meetings, but Jean & I have been in Africa for two of a three weeks expedition. After attending the World Orchid Conference in Johannesburg we are touring, and will tell you all about it sometime. Without wishing to brag, that now means we have visited every continent except the two Polar Regions. Even then we have been above the Arctic Circle in Alaska, but that's still part of North America. We stood on the ocean (nine feet of frozen sea water).

With regard to the proposed six month's trial of new meeting arrangements we erred. Epidendrum stamfordianum Bateman 1838

Epidendrum stamfordianum was named after Stamford, Count of Stamford, a 19th Century British orchid grower and collector. Please take care when you write the species name of this orchid, as many people spell it incorrectly, falsely making a connection with the famous American centre of learning, Stanford University.

The genus *Epidendrum* (from 2 Greek words – epi “upon” and dendros “a tree”) is one of the largest orchid genres, with over 1,000 known species throughout tropical America and the Caribbean. *Epidendrum stamfordianum* is a common orchid in Central America from southern Mexico to Panama. It can also be found in Colombia and Venezuela. It is an epiphyte found at an altitude of 20 – 900m, growing on the large branches of tree crowns. It is generally found in areas with a definite dry season, and needs a winter rest when grown in Townsville. I grow it among my *Cattleyas*, with no special attention, though it seems to like slightly moisture-retentive media. Unusually, flower spikes arise from the base of a newly formed mature pseudobulb, one of the few orchid species to do this.

Growers should be warned that this orchid does not like being repotted, and can sulk in a dormant state for up to 2 years before responding to cultivation. My plant is now flowering for the first time since I repotted it in 2012.
