Novice/New growers Report: - On Sunday 24th January, 67 members and visitors gathered at the Townsville Orchid Society Inc. Hall, Charles Street, Kirwan for the first meeting for the year 2016. Attendance was very good to start off our activities for the coming year. If you have any cultural topic you would like any of our more experience growers to talk about at our future meetings, do not hesitate to mention your ideas to me at the next meeting. All members stood to observe a minute silence in memory of our late member Jean White who passed away on the 1st December 2015. May she now rest in peace.

Our subject for the meeting was mainly for the new growers and how Warren repots his Cattleva orchids, he detailed the potting media he uses, size of pots required, cutting Tools (Secateurs etc. sterilized in Trisodium Phosphate for at least 20 minutes), plant support material, and the rhizome cutting procedure to protect from bacterial infection. Remove old dry sheaths and old rotten roots, clean bracts around pseudobulbs. This is where scale and aphids like to hide. Divide plant with a rhizome of at least 4 pseudo bulbs (minimum 3), seal cut with a fungicide solution, place plant with sealed cut against side of pot leaving a gap to other side for a 2 year growth. Add potting mix lightly tapping side of pot to the level of the rhizome. Do not cover the rhizome as it may rot the eyes and new growths.

Make sure you sign your name in the attendance book as it is important in relation to our Christmas Party. Special comfort for Wal and Jean just to let you know that at this time, we are thinking of you both. Another member Ray Robinson is not very well, so to all our members who are not enjoying the best of health at present, may there be better days ahead for everybody. We are planning to have a bus trip to Ingham for their Field Day in April, so think about it as a list will be going around at the meeting for names to fill the a bus.

There were some beautiful Vanda orchids on display at our last monthly meeting.

Once again we were treated to a wonderful afternoon tea also many thanks to you all for your support with donations of Raffle Prizes for the Multi Raffle table and ticket sales. Next Novice/New Growers meeting will be held on the 28th February at the Townsville Orchid Society Inc. Hall starting at 1.00pm. Hoping to see you all there again.

In Noel's Bush House 42

Doritis pulcherrima var. buyssoniana x var. red "Brighton", Lindley 1832

I was very surprised, when I was researching this orchid, to discover that *Doritis pulcherrima* is considered to be a terrestrial orchid. It is found in sandy soils in an area stretching from Northern India through Myanmar, Thailand and other South East Asian countries and south from Yunnan in China to Sumatra and Borneo. I have had several varieties of this species for a long time and I have always treated them as epiphytes (!) - growing them in pots with 50% Quincan gravel and 50% bark. For me, they tend to resent having too much moisture, as the roots seem to easily rot in wet conditions, so I would be fearful of potting them in a terrestrial orchid mix.



Doritis pulcherrima var. buyssoniana x var. red Perhaps I should experiment the next time I repot this plant (and keep a very sharp eye on its progress). That would be in spring, when new roots are in vigorous growth. Maybe I will split the plant and pot one half as a terrestrial and one as an epiphyte. In that way, if one plant hates the mixture and dies, I shouldn't lose the other, fingers crossed. This orchid is a hybrid between *Doritis pulcherrima* var. buyssoniana (now renamed by the botanists as Phalaenopsis buyssoniana) and a red form of Doritis pulcherrima (now renamed as Phalaenopsis pulcherrima). I was going to tell you that a hybrid between two varieties of the same species is still considered to be a species (as my current label shows), BUT, because of the renaming to two different species, I have found in OrchidWiz that this particular hybrid, Phal. buyssoniana x Phal. pulcherrima. is now called Phalaenopsis Yen Orion. Sadly this means that I will have to remember, at our next meeting, to place this plant on the hybrid table, not among the species. Curse those botanists messing with my labels!

All the Doritis species have now been renamed as Phalaenosis, and should be grown in a similar way (but as terrestrials), with the proviso that they need much brighter light than Phalaenopsis plants to produce their flowers in abundance. The flowers are produced for a long time on a lengthening flower spike up to a metre long, with up to ten flowers open at a time. A well-grown plant will produce several flower spikes (mine has five).

The name Doritis comes from the Greek word 'dory' meaning spear, the symbol of Aphrodite (Venus), metaphorically "very beautiful". 'Pulcherrima' also means 'very beautiful'. The word 'buyssoniana' is dedicated to Count François du Buysson, a French botanist and orchid collector in the 19th and early 20th Century.
