

#### RAMBLING ON (or so I have been told)

March already and a scary thing.... Only 3 months to our Celebration and a lot of work still to be done. Several more sponsors have been secured, just a case of chasing them up now. The \$100 donation given last month plus some of a donation from Wal will go towards buying a whipper snipper for the big public raffle. We are still seeking assistance with... suggestions... digging fork, rake, spade, shovel, lawn rake... decorative pots, hose and connections... tap timer, hose reel. I believe there are a number of members who do not really care about this function. I'll bet my bottom dollar they will be there to reap the benefits from the event though.

Just a thought - how many members know what "TQOC Inc" stand for – Tropical Queensland Orchid Council - 53 years ago, several members of TOS saw the need for a Council to represent Orchid Societies in an area from Mackay to Mt Isa and through to Cairns and the Atherton Tablelands. The Council includes Societies whose members grow not only orchids but also foliage plants (NOT garden plants as such, some foliage can also be classed as garden plants, but if they are grown in pots and can be moved they are foliage plants. Garden plants have a different growing habit and cannot be grown in pots in a shaded house. They need sun)

There are 3 meetings a year, 2 quarterly (early and late) with a yearly Conference held in June, including an Orchid Show. Each Society has 2 delegates with one voting right. Every 2 years an Election of Office bearers is held, with nominees standing as often as they liked.

Conferences have been held by large Societies who could run them, with Conferences in the past held in Mackay, Bowen, Townsville, Ingham, Innisfail, Cairns, and more recently Atherton has joined us. Some Societies have held Conferences only once: Tville & District Orchid and Allied Plants Assn Inc, Ayr, Proserpine, Tully and Mt Isa. Sadly the Mt Isa Orchid Society no longer exist, while the remainder are now not in a position to stage these events.

With this, the 52<sup>nd</sup> Conference and Show, we sadly say farewell to yearly Conferences (2 yearly from now), due to an aging membership, no eager younger members to take over from us oldies; not only an aging membership, but there have been incursions from southern Clubs who over the years have muscled into the June long weekend which cuts into registration to the northern conferences... Venues etc. are there, it is just the willing workers and accepting Society who will put in the now 2 yearly planning period that are needed. Previously the Conferences have not been as large as this coming event (except for 2015 when AOC Inc. and TQOC In. combined for a once only event). While Wal Nicholson was alive he was keen to have a large event in 2017 to celebrate the 70<sup>th</sup> birthday of our Society. It was then passed to me when he was no longer able to carry on and the Committee stepped up to the challenge. I do not believe there will be another TQOC Conference of this size, certainly not in my life time.

Who know what will happen with the next Conference. Townsville could do the next one BUT it is not the "done thing" to run Conference so close together by a previous hosting Club.

So, I ask all members for your support in making this TQOC Conference a memorable event and to welcome all our guest registrants.

Many members were surprised when Warren Sewell resigned from running the Sunday afternoon Novice/ New Growers sessions. I had spoken to him prior to last month and asked him to stay on, however his health was the catalyst which resulted in his decision to 'bow out'. Clara told me after Warren had made his announcement he could not go on as he was having a lot of health problems and found it difficult to get in and out of the car with the way his legs were playing up. On Saturday (11<sup>th</sup>) at the Judges seminar his knee was causing a lot of problems, but he is due to have it seen to in April, hopefully there will be some relief for him.

On behalf of the membership of the TOS I thank you Warren for the time and effort you put into the Sunday afternoons, they are well attended and very popular. Regrettably times must change, something which I hate, I am not a person who likes change, I would be happy to go on and on and.....but even I know it can't be, so we now must look to the future and ask members what they would like for Items of interest. Perhaps we could elaborate on Commentary on plants and ask some of the members for their input. The section is in Peters hands with support from myself as I have been doing the plant commentary on and off over a period of 30 odd years.

The Committee know that reporting and dividing plants is always popular. Any member who would like to have a problem plant looked at, please bring it to the meeting. With plants for reporting or cutting up, please remember to bring pots and potting mixes as the Club does not have such things on hand for demonstrations (also cutting implements).

Our afternoon teas are a great success and a chance for members to gab on to one another, the length of time we now have is suitable. Special thanks must go to Joan and her team and to all members who supply goodies for this pleasurable time.

Lastly, Congrats to Noel and the Society's thanks for taking on the task of Bullet Editor. If you have an article or sales advert you would like to include, please see Noel. Also, please support Robyn and Ruth in their endeavours to bring the Society's display together for the Conference.
