Hospitality (Ruth Whiting):

Catering – putting up price to \$5 for sandwiches. \$4 for cakes and coffee.

Members out the back – kitchen staff will need to sit down at the table at times but no-one else. Seats to be available for general public. Marquees will be set up out the back for those who want to stay and chat.

No urn out the back – members to get drinks inside and take them out to the marquee.

Publicity (Leonie Johnson)

Advertising for the Show – price has gone up by more than \$800. Applying a 30% discount at that price. Leonie is pursuing this to find out why it is so much more expensive.

Internet advertising with the Bulletin is extra.

Try to get an editorial from the Townsville Bulletin or some story in the paper.

Advertise on Thursday and Saturday. Friday – get it put into the free community list.

Leonie will do up a flyer advertising the Show.

General Business:

- 1. Bill expressed concern that TOS Inc did not have a budget like a business. He suggested that we need to be more business-like in our approach.
- 2. Information from Jeff (via Robert) Robert will run the shop. Still need more helpers.
 - Raffle float is in the safe.
 - Barcodes for the show sales are in paper bags in the Office.
 - TOS QR code has been registered with the Queensland Government QR code system.
- 3. Bus to leave for Ingham at 6.30pm. Robert in charge of the bus.
- 4. Bowen Field Day -
 - Quote for 57-seater bus is \$1 540. (25 x \$50 not including lunch = \$1250) loss of \$290.
 - Quote for 24-seater bus is \$1 210. (20 x \$45 = \$900) (20 x \$50 = \$1 000) loss of \$310/\$210 respectively.
- 5. Issues at general meetings.

Plant Competition

- Greg Kelly discussed an email that he had sent to all Committee members regarding the emerging situations with the placement of plants, judging, registrar's choice and pencilling.
- Greg indicated that he was not trying to change Ted Boon's role but was concerned
 about the situation when Ted is not available. When Ted is not at the meeting there is
 no-one stepping up to help. The Society needs to put something in place to ensure the
 plant competition runs smoothly when Ted is not there. One suggestion is that members
 need to learn where to table their own plants. This occurs in other clubs.
- Should we be putting all orchid types together rather than having lots of different sections?

- Greg has organised for Reg Dix to assist members with placement of plants a learning exercise for members. Not sure how it will go but worth a try. Possibly the number of sections could be reduced.
- Ted Boon indicated that he is meeting with Reg Dix to discuss the problem.

Technical Advisor

- Need a technical advisor as Charlie Truscott has resigned from that position.
- This Sunday, Reg Dix will do a PowerPoint, so no technical advisor will be necessary.
- 6. TQOC Meeting -
 - a motion was passed at the meeting club hosting the conference may apply for a grant of up to \$3000 for hosting club to assist with the provision of quality speakers.
 - TOS will provide about 70 of our tables on the day before the Orchid Fair.
 - Mackay wants the club hosting the next TQOC Conference to be responsible for the organising and running of the Orchid Fair in the years prior to that club holding the Conference.
- 7. Rosters for Door and Raffle will be organised and we will be advised.
- 8. People at Bunnings want us to have a table on display possibly just before the Show. Not sure what is happening. Need to check with John Johnson.
- 9. Tag-alongs re email questioning as to whether tag-alongs would be allowed at the Ingham Field Day. Greg checked with the President of Ingham and that information is not correct tag-alongs are allowed.
- 10. Anzac Day next meeting. No need to change.
- 11. Bill Hughes cloakroom table where plants are on hold is a problem. It was agreed to continue with this table.
- 12. Ruth. Will the bus stop at the Yabulu servo or Veales Rd on the way to Ingham?
- 13. Ruth and Robert will look at erecting the shade out the back.

President Greg Kelly indicated that the tabling of plants at the last meeting was not good. He had hoped to commence a system whereby members place their own plants in the correct sections instead of Ted Boon placing them all. His concern is that when Ted is not at the meeting (and Ted has been unwell), no-one knows what to do. This was to happen today, but Ted continued with his practice of placing plants.

Greg believed he was being undermined as President and considered stepping down as President. Greg further stated that whilst sympathetic to Ted's situation, he was responsible for the planning and running of the club. The President also advised that he had asked, on a number of occasions, that a judge be appointed to run the plant judging if Ted was not available.

- 6. Reg Dix Presentation; Preparation of Plants for Orchid Shows.
 - to clean plants, don't use a shine spray.
 - 50% milk/50%water is good to clean leaves use a tissue.
 - should be no evidence of manipulating plants.
 - more information on presentation of plants was given.

7. Charlie Truscott - molasses

- · great orchid fertilizer for plants that need sugar.
- microbes in your pots in your soil feed on sugars.
- provides microbes with nutrients. natural way of getting trace elements in plants.
- molasses deters pests in the plants ants and grasshoppers. Charlie uses 1½ ml per litre of water. Spray onto leaves.
- uses molasses every time he fertilizes already in chelated form.
- refined form (from supermarket) is not suitable available from Lamberts in Fleming St 2L for \$5.
