The Management Committee looked at the ideas from the sub-committee, looking at ways of introducing these ideas to the monthly meetings next year. More will come out after further coordination from within the committee.

- **Novices** – we are looking at when people should be moved from Novices to Open. The committee was asked if there could be changes to this. If you are an Open grower and believe you are not at that level and would like to revert to novice, please approach Troy or Jan. We will consider everyone individually at committee meetings. We agree that some members who were made Open growers after 3 years (current by-laws) – should be in the Novice section. We will make decisions by individual growers.

Judging Plants – Reg Dix

- Reg chose a variety of plants from the display to explain to the members what the judges are looking for. He explained that points are given for 1) Shape - 33 points; 2) Colour - 33points; 3) Substance/display/stem habit – other 33 points. He compared two Paphiopedilum.
- Alison demonstrated how she would dress her Phalaenopsis for displaying in a show. Reg noted that it had good colour but was very flat across the bottom – not circular, or oval in shape as is how it should be. The flower needs to ‘look out’ at the judges. In order to do that, Alison showed how she worked on each petal to ensure they were facing forwards. Reg recommended that the best time to dress the flower is about 3.30 – 4.00 in the afternoon when the plant is warm and flexible.
- **What is the difference between a hybrid and a species?**
Hybrids are plants that have been made from a combination of different species.
A species is a plant that grows wild in the bush. But nature can also produce a natural hybrid in the wild.

Jeff Knowles – Technical Officer

- talked about salt. See leaflet.
- Spoke about how sometimes, the names of some orchids are questionable e.g. a plant that Jeff bought had two genus names on it – *Oncidium* and **Trichocentrum**.
- Name labels at the shows– reason for these is to make the name of the orchid clear so that people are not digging around your plant for your tags, then putting them back into the wrong pot.
- Being members of Australian Orchid Council (AOC)– your flowers can be awarded. Our Society is a member of the AOC. Their publication has a list of the names of the new orchids that have been crossed. In one of the Orchid Australia publications, Jeff found the name of a hybrid that Peter Lucke had developed. Peter spoke about the process of developing a new hybrid – it was 7 years from hybridising to registering it. Once, they were supposed to flower the plant before registering it but because when people other than the hybridiser were flowering it earlier, they were registering them as their own. Now, those rules have changed to allow the original hybridiser to register them straight away – and find out later if was worth it.
- Ways to test your sphagnum moss to see if your plant needs watering;
 - 1) Test plant by feeling the weight of the plant to see if it is heavy.
 - 2) Put finger in. or
 - 3) buy a moisture meter to see how wet it is. Bought from Leathers on Ross River Road but able to buy at other places.
- Spring has sprung. Add a growth hormone during Spring to give your roots some growth. Not an NPK fertiliser – not food, only a tonic.

Afternoon tea was taken.

The continuous raffle was held.
